


Make a windmill




- Fold a 15cm square piece of paper twice diagonally to form a small triangle.
- Open the paper out.
- Mark a point on each fold, 8cm from the outer corner.
- Cut along the folds up to the marked point.


- Fold alternate halves of each corner into the centre of the square, slightly overlapping the centre point each time.
- Push a sharp pencil through the centre of the square to make a hole.

- Make two holes in the cardboard tube.
- Push a straw through the holes and ensure that it turns freely.
- Secure the straw at the back with a small lump of play dough.

- Push the straw through the holes in the folded paper square.
- Trim off the excess straw at the front of the windmill.
- Secure at the front with another lump of play dough.
